Holstein Record Is Shattered

A 17 year old cow named Minnow Creek Eden Delight 2494802 (EX) has delighted J E Taylor, Orange, Virginia with a new high in lifetime butterfat production for the Holstein breed.

She is officially credited with a "career" total of 10,671 lbs. in 246,979 lbs. of milk by the Holstein-Friesian Association of America.

The previous record was 10,599 lbs of butterfat. It was completed in 1954 by Pansco Hazel 1817843 (EX) in the F F Pellissier herd, Whittier, California.

Delighting owners is an old habit of the aptly-named "Delight" Still going strong at Taylor's Meadowfarm Dairy, she ranks among the world's most famous dairy cows

She is best remembered as the first registered Holstein cow ever to compile five official yearly records of more than 1,000 lbs of butterfat on twice daily milking.

All five were made at Lakefield Farms, Clarkston, Michigan. Shortly thereafter, the Lakefield herd was dispersed and "Delight" was purchased by her present owner.

In the process, she gained a national reputation as a top-ranking brood cow. With nine direct descendants, she was the target of some of the hottest and most spirited bidding in breed history
