arena which seats approxi-1,500 people, was dedicated in January 1931 at an ap. proximate cost of \$1,440,000. The large arena with a seating capacity of 7,639 was added later at a cost of \$1, 250,000 and dedicated in January, 1939.

Total area under roof in the main building and arena is between 13 and 14 acres with about 570,000 square feet of floor space. The main commercial hall extends the entire 800 feet length of the main building, and is 218 feet wide Approximately 1/2 of the floor space is devoted to the display of tractors and farm machinery, while the other half is taken up by dairy and other barn equipcommercial feeds. ment. fertilizers, nursery left out of the expo seeds. poultry and other addition to the stock, equipment, farm service or- livestock judging ganizations, and home apphances.






