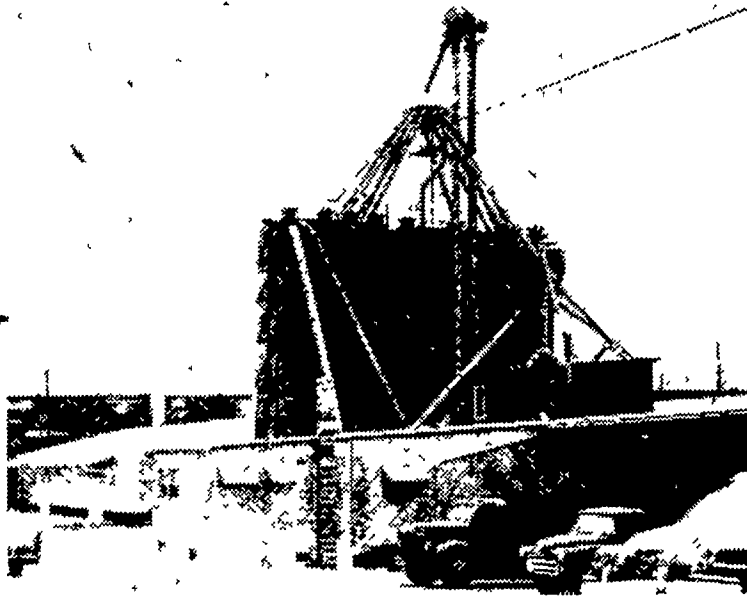

Co-op Plans Open House

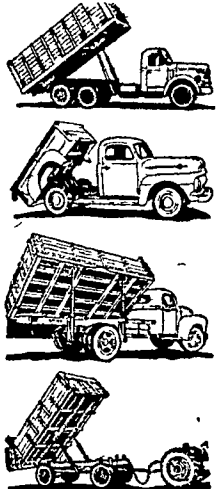

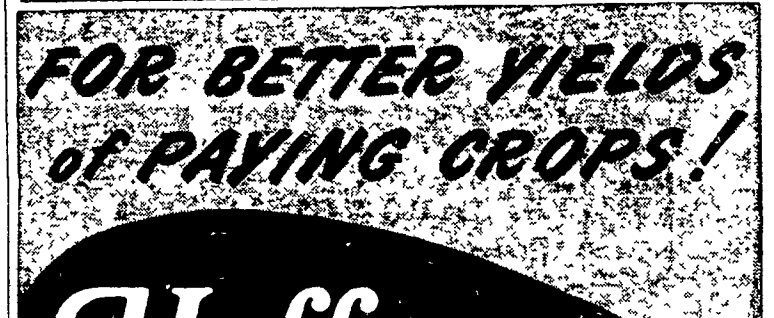
