been curtailed because of insufficient appropriation of funds from the state legislature.

County vegetable growers said they will ask the state organization to contact the state legislators to explain the curtailment of the research program. In the resolution, the growers said they feel certain they can supply the people of the state fresh vegetables of higher quality and lower cost than can be supplied from areas outside our state, however they feel that a vegetable research program equal to that in the areas with which they compete is necessary.

Other topics for discussion at the all day meeting were vegetable sprays, insect problems, labor recruiting, and soil management practices
