PREVENT EGG BREAKAGE

Care in handling can prevent egg breakage on the farm, says F. H. Leuschner, Penn State extension poultry specialist. Collect eggs 3 or 4 times a day. Do not fill egg baskets too full. Keep records that will show the results of care in handling and its effects on breakage.

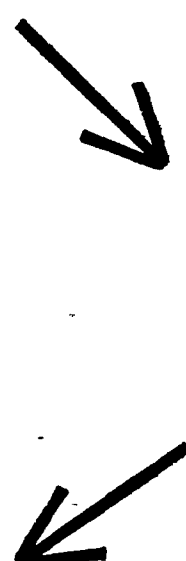

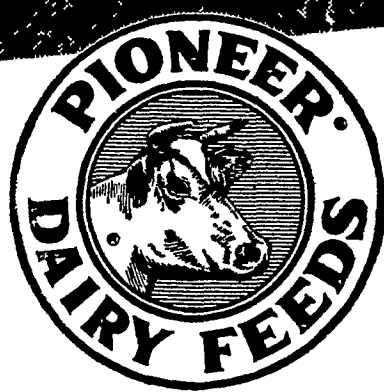
