RECORD TURKEY CROP IN PROSPECT

If turkey growers carry out their turkey production intentions for 1960, they will produce about 87 million turkeys, compared with 82 million last year, an increase of 6 per cent More specifically, current intentions, as reported by the Crop Reporting Board last week, indicate that 22,024,000 heavy white turkeys will be raised this year, up 21 per cent; 52,189-,000 bronze and other heavy breeds, up 8 per cent, and 12,621,000 light breed turkeys, a decrease of 18 per cent.
