do, a hat should never be narrower than the face. Both hat and hair style should have some size to balance too-heavy hips, a hat with a wide brim worn straight seems to shorten the figure; the same hat tilted seems to add height. An off-the-face hair also adds height while a drooping brim or trim near the hairline makes the figure look shorter.

BUY SHOES THAT FIT YOUR FEET AND NEEDS

The shoe that fits perfectly is the shoe that wears longest. Buying good shoes that fit your feet and needs will save you money and grief.

A quality shoe is pliable but sturdy. Material that is too stiff will crack. Soles must be heavy enough to offer protection, yet flexible enough to bend and snap back into shape thousands of times.

Check the linings. They should be smoothly finished, preferably of leather. Loose,

riding or wrinkled linings irritate the foot and produce corns. Innersoles should be flat and firmly attached to the base of the shoe. When the shoe upper is unlined, look for flat, even inside seams and avoid ridges and raw-unfinished edges.

Shoes should fit your needs as well as your feet. The same shoe will not serve for dress, work and casual wear. Buying different types of shoes to fit each different need will be more economical and better for your foot health in the long run.

To get the right size have your shoes fitted, don't just buy them by size alone. Adult feet grow and change so you shouldn't judge by your old shoe size. Be sure you walk with your new shoes on to see that the heel chings without slipping and your feet don't feel squeezed.

BE A WISE BELT BUYER

When buying a belt or a dress with a belt, choose with care. An attractive and appropriate belt is important to the appearance of a garment.

Belts of self-fabric are usually the best choice. However, belts of contrasting color or texture can be an interesting accent for some garments and figures. A contrasting belt may be of fabric, such as faille or grosgrain, and might pick up a color from the dress or provide a pleasing color combination.

Good quality leather or patent belts sometimes can provide just the right touch

if well-chosen, but cheap commercial belts, such as many plastics, often distract from the appearance of a costume. Remember that contrasting or wide belts make the waistline appear larger and the figure shorter. A belt ¾ to 1 inch wide is becoming to most women. Tall, slender figures may wear wider belts while short or thick figures should not wear belts over 1 to 1½ inches wide.

Storage stocks of potatoes held by growers and local dealers on January 1 of this year totaled 97.5 million

hundredweight, according to latest Crop Reporting Board figures. This is 10 per cent below holdings on January 1 a year ago, but 4 per cent above 1949-58 average stock of 93.4 million cwt. Disappearance of storage potatoes during 1959 is reported to be the second highest of record in the past 10 years, having been exceeded only in Dec. 1958. Stocks of storage potatoes in storage on January 1 totaled 5,677,000 cwt., or 30 per cent from a year ago and 17 per cent above average and the largest since January 1, 1954.

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
