## Delmarva - Georgia

### Higher Prices Noted Here

Delmarva reported sales of 779,500 head at farm prices of 18.20 - 20.60 for the 24 hour period ending 10:30 Friday morning.

Estimated slaughter in Delmarva for the week end is 610,000 head compared to 509,000 head last week end.

The Delmarva broiler fed ratio for the week ending February 19 was up one point from the previous week at 4.0. Broilers averaged 18.18 cents per pound and mash cost \$92.00 per ton.

Georgia reported sales of 1,346,000 head at prices ranging from 18 to 19.

### Fluid Milk Surplus Still Building Up

Production of fluid milk was reported sharply higher than for the same period of last year at all points except Atlanta. Only slight increases were noted over last wk. Bottling demand was irregular with higher cheese production. Prices at New York unchanged at \$5.32 per 40 quart unit.
