Kreider, Quarryville R1, suc-
ceeded Robert Groff, Quar-
ryville R3, as secretary of
the group. Elections were
held at the Farm Bureau
Auditorium on Monday eve-
ning.

Treasurer, Charles Long
reported that the association
handled over \$90,000 last
year. The officers of the or-
ganization along with Victor
Plasto, Associate County Ag-
ent were instructed to inves-
tigate the possibilities of in-
stalling a ledger system of
bookkeeping for the asso-
ciation.

Herbert Gilmore, State
Supervisor of the Dairy Herd
Improvement Associations
told members that Lancaster
County with its approximat-
ely 400 DHIA members and
175 Owner Sampler mem-
bers is by far the largest as-
sociation in the state. "And
of course Lancaster County
has the largest board of di-
rectors", he said.

In other business, the di-
rectors voted to give full
voting rights to the various
breed representatives. Breed
association members may al-
so make motions from the
floor, but they may not hold
office on the board.

costly procedure." For the
most part, insecticide-fertiliz-
er combinations in the State
are used on potato ground for
wire worm control. The next
largest amount is for grub
control on turf.

Adams said the best meth-
od for combining insecticide
and fertilizer, although com-
plex, is to impregnate fertili-
zer granules with the insecti-
cide. Another method is to mix
the two in liquid form—a
process requiring special in-
structions.
