

Deadlines Are Announced By A.S.C. Office

Price support on the 1959 corn crop is still available at \$1.24 per bushel, through either farm-stored loans or purchase agreements, Landis G. Becker of the Lancaster County Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation office said today. Interested farmers should contact the office. Final date for application is May 31.

Becker also said farmers should enroll early to be guaranteed payment for the practices they plan to carry out under the Agricultural Conservation Program this year. To date, 170 farmers

have enrolled, and practices have been approved in the amount of \$18,000. Total allocation for the county is \$120,000. Soil tests must be made by either the County Agent or State College for any practice requiring the use of lime.

Under the wheat feed program, farmers may harvest up to 30 acres of wheat, regardless of the allotment, if all the wheat is fed on the farm where it is produced.

March 31 is the end of the 1959 wool marketing year. Wool growers have until April 30 to file for in-

centive payments on wool or lambs sold between April 1, 1959 and March 31, 1960.

To make application the farmer must submit sales slips showing name of buyer and seller, date of sale, pounds of wool or weight of lamb sold, amount received and the slip must be signed by the buyer, Becker said.

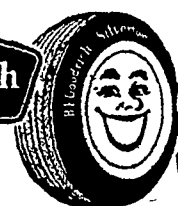
