Leaders for the group are Virgil VanNatta, Raymond K. Henry, Harry Smith, and Elvin Krantz. Drumore

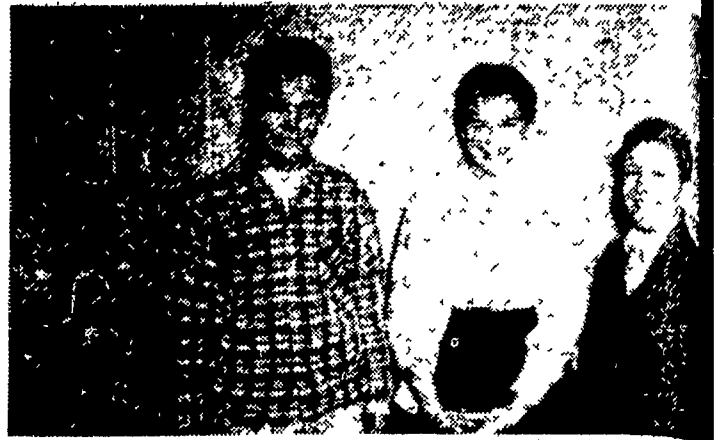

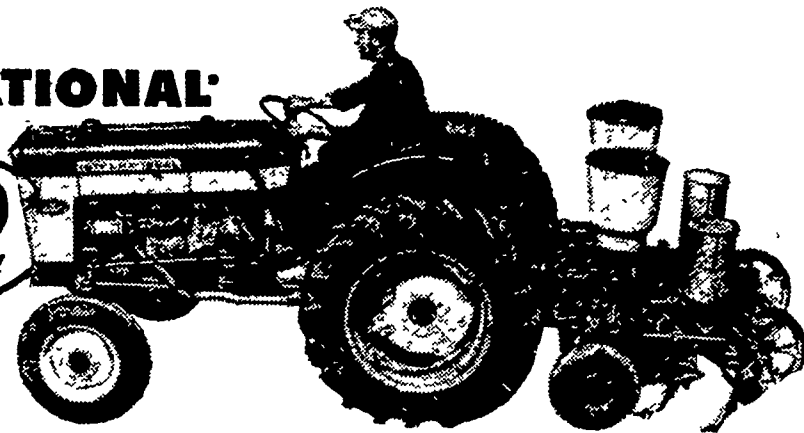
