**Insecticide Tolerances Announced
By Pa. Department of Agri.**

HARRISBURG — State Secretary of Agriculture William L Henning has announced that safe food additive and pesticide tolerance standards for Pennsylvania have been issued to conform with a list of safe chemical additives and pesticide chemical tolerances that have been listed in the Federal Register under the authority of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act.

Secretary Henning said that the regulatory changes under the State's General Food Law are necessary "so that our farmers, food processors, manufacturers and packers will have a clear guide as to the Commonwealth's requirements concerning additives"

"It shall be the policy of the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture to endorse other safe chemical additives and tolerances as they are published in the Federal Register in the interests of uniformity unless the best interests of the citizens of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania are served by some variance," Secretary Henning said

The regulations became effective March 4.

Approximately 300 food additives and 100 pesticide chemicals are covered under these regulations. No toler-

ances or new regulations on the use of herbicides or growth substances have been published.


Secretary Henning added that the use or amount of an agricultural chemical or food additive must be consistent with the provisions of other Pennsylvania acts or regulations issued under the authority of such acts.


