in Buildings," was written by R. A. St. George, H. R. Johnson, and R. J. Kowal of the Division of Forest Insect Research of USDA's Forest Service

Illustrated with numerous photographs and line drawings, the booklet suggests points to watch for and pitfalls to avoid in building or buying. In "do-it-yourself" language it tells how to conduct regular inspection for termites, and how a home owner can counter-attack if invaded.

There are also sections on chemical treatment of woods, and chemical preventive and control methods in general.

The authors point out that some woods are by their nature more resistant than others to termites. So far as is known, the kinds and grades of lumber most resistant to termite attack are foundation grade California redwood, all-heart southern tide-water red cypress, very pitchy southern pine—"lightwood", and heartwood of eastern red cedar.
