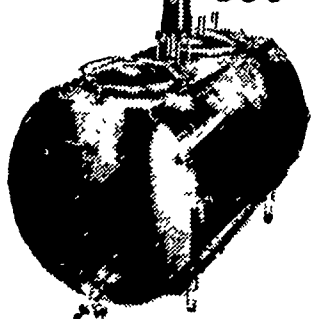

Be ready for arrival of baby chicks, urges Carl Dossin, Penn State extension poultry specialist. Properly adjust the brooder stove, provide litter on the floor, put water in fountains, have feed and grit available, and set up a guard about 18 inches from the outside edge of the hover.

Use a high-quality fresh inoculant for the particular legume you are seeding, advises Clarence Bryner, Penn State extension agronomist.

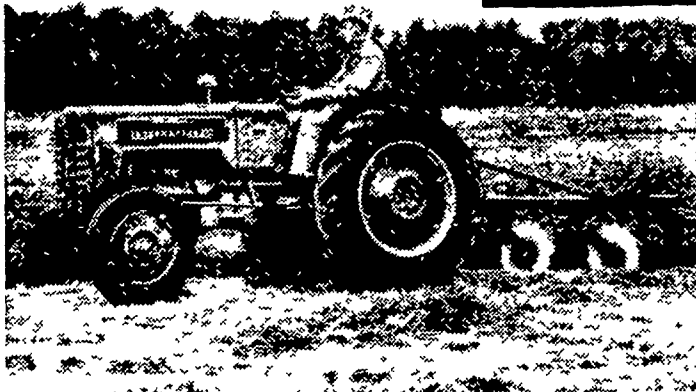
