Dr. Guyton advises. "Burn ing out the nest may result in damage to the tree, hence it is not recommended.

"To protect trees with a spray, use arsenate of lead, three pounds in 100 gallons of water; or DDT 50 per cent wettable powder at the rate of two pounds in 100 gallons of water (4 tablespoons in one gallon); or Malathion 25 per cent wettable powder at the rate of two pounds in 100 gallons of water (15 tablespoons in 1 gallon.))"


