

Holstein Tour Is Next Week

A tour through a frozen food plant as well as visits to several dairy farms will be on the agenda of the Spring Tour of the Lancaster County Holstein Breeders on Wednesday, April 27. County Holstein Breeders and their families will tour the facilities of the Pet Ritz frozen food plant at Chambersburg where they will see the baking and freezing of over 40 kinds of fruit and cream pies.

The following herds will be observed in the Chambersburg area: I K Nitterhouse and Nelson Myers, both of Chambersburg and Adam Martin of Maughansville, Maryland.

The tour will leave the Conestoga Transportation Company terminal on East Chestnut Street promptly at 7:00 a.m. and, after an evening meal with some of the members of the Franklin County Holstein Breeders, will return to Lancaster about 9:00 p.m.

National 4-H Conclave Opens

About 200 of the Nation's top-ranking 4-H Club members from 49 states and Puerto Rico will attend the 30th National 4-H Conference in Washington, D.C., today through April 29. With the youth will be 100 State 4-H leaders who will participate in 4-H program workshops.

This will be the first time the annual Conference has not been held in June, and the first time both delegates and leaders will stay at the new 4-H Center formally opened last year when President Eisenhower cut the ribbon. Conference theme will be "Getting Set for the Sixties." Stressed for the young people will be "Know Your Government" and citizenship for the adult workers, leadership.

Delegates will be two young men and two young women from each state except Alaska, and from Puerto Rico, chosen from 2,254,000 4-H'ers belonging to about 93,000 clubs. Those selected were named because of exceptional achievements in leadership, citizenship, and community service, and for completing various farming, homemaking, and community-benefiting projects.

The Conference will be supervised by the Cooperative Extension Service of the U.S. Department of Agriculture and the State land grant colleges. Assisting will be staff members of the

two 4-H supporting organizations, the National 4-H Club Foundation, headquartered at the Center, and the National Committee on Boys and Girls Club Work, Chicago.

Most of the assemblies and other meetings will be held

at the Center, 7100 Connecticut Avenue. The public is invited to any of the general sessions. On "Friends of 4-H" day, April 29, a group of widely-known persons in business and industry will be named "Partners in 4-H", a newly-designated honor, for notable contributions to 4-H Club Work.

Each will receive a certificate of recognition from Under Secretary of Agriculture True D. Morse during a special ceremony in the Department Auditorium on Constitution Ave.

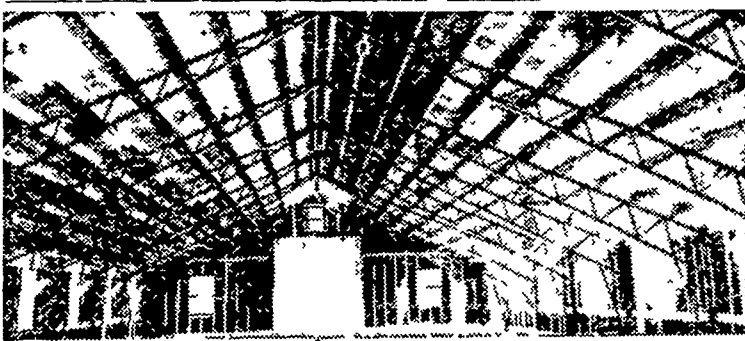

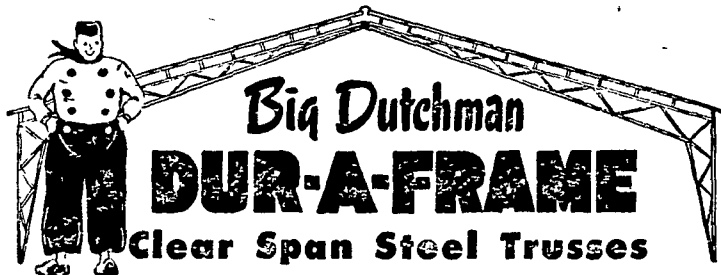

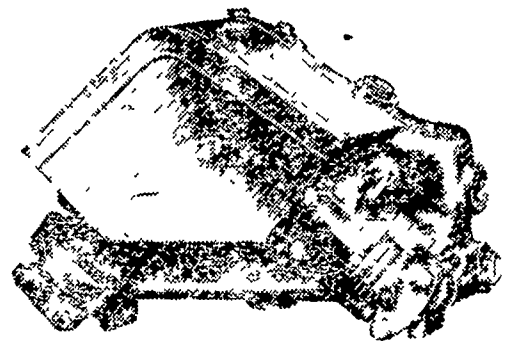
