Certified Egg Use On The Increase

Ending its second full year of operations, the Pennsylvania Certified Egg program administered by the State Agriculture Department continues to show expanding benefits to voluntary participants.

Only four egg handling plants started packing Pennsylvania Certified eggs in April 1958. Now there are 33 plants packing more than 2 million dozen eggs a month under the Department's strict quality control program rules.

There are six additional plants who have applications pending with the Bureau of Markets.

During the past 24 months, more than 41 million dozen Certified eggs have been marketed. The second year of operation shows a volume increase of 43 percent greater than in the first year. Much of the increased volume was in the sale of case eggs to restaurants, institutions and hotels.

Consumer egg cartons bearing the "Blue Keystone" seal have become more common as many of the leading egg retailers have shifted

exclusively to Certified egg sales.

The quality control program is backed by consumer education and promotion by the poultry industry and the Bureau of Markets.

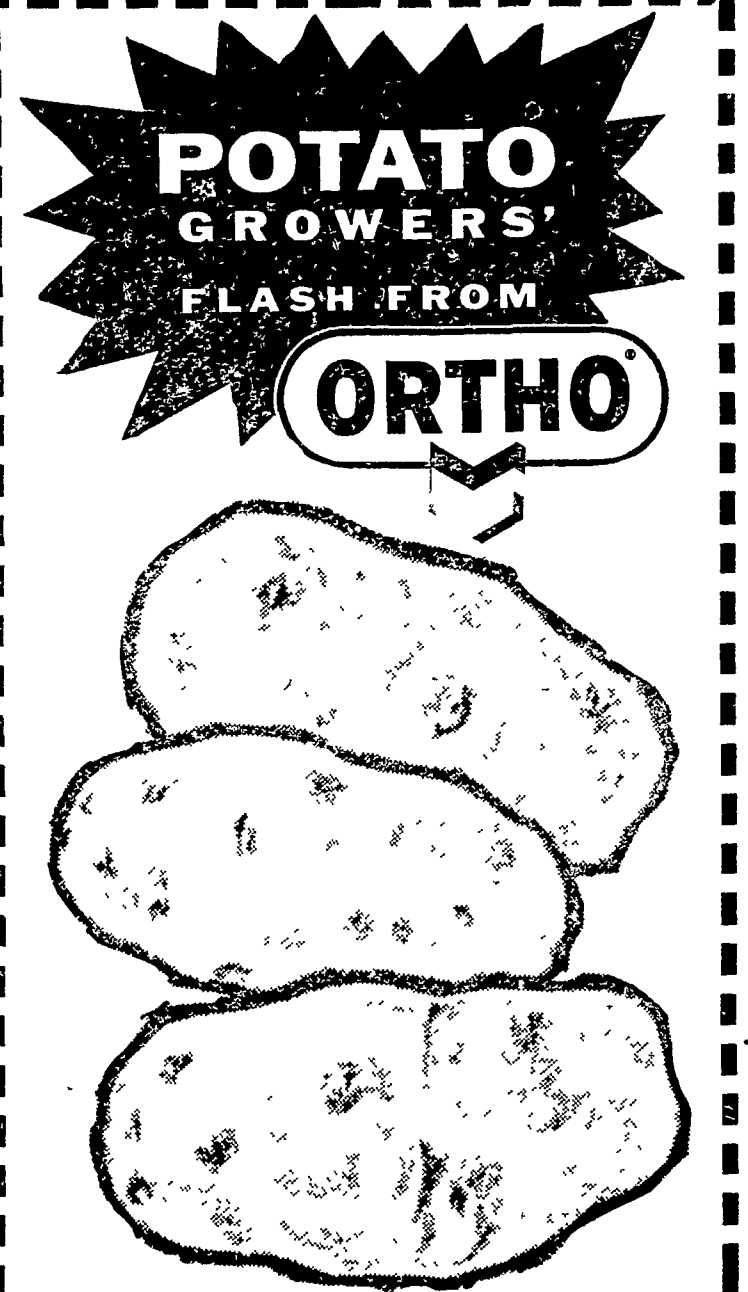

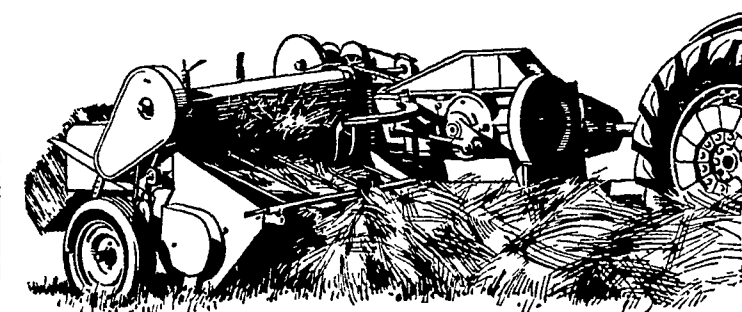
