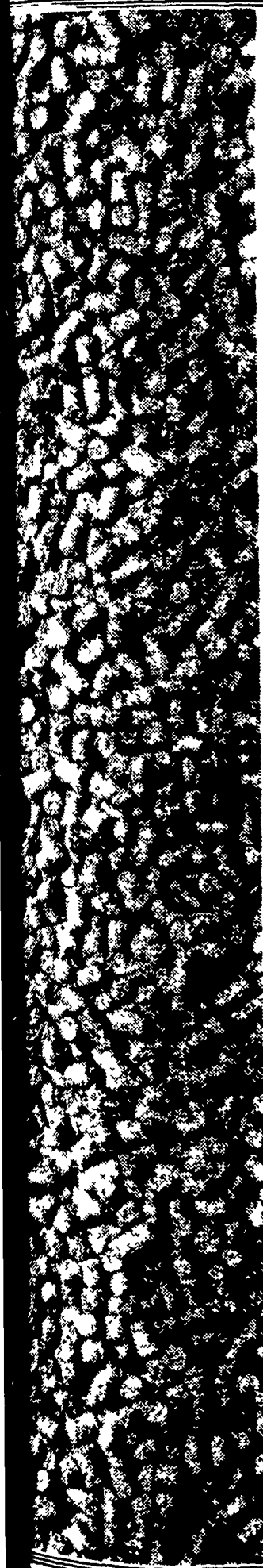

be fed out as market hogs
The 29 gilts were brought onto the farm in January and began farrowing February. Several of the best boars have been reserved for sale as breeding stock and a few of the top notch gilts have been kept for replacement stock to build the herd to the desired 60 sows.

The eight sows in the farrowing crates at the present time have raised a total of 85 healthy pigs.

One of the reasons for the success of the breeding program, and these were all gilts, is the practice of breeding the gilts at the first sign of heat and rebreeding again 24 hours later. Gilts are bred to farrow the first time at about one year of age.

Disease has not been a problem on the farm. Henkel and Little contribute
