

Wins Scholarship

Harry R. Mumma, son of Mr. and Mrs. Harry S. Mumma, Manheim R1, has been awarded a Pennsylvania Power & Light Company agricultural scholarship for study at Pennsylvania State University's College of Agriculture, it has been announced today by Chas E. Oakes, PP&L board chairman and chief executive officer.

A senior at Hempfield high school, Harry is a member of the school band and orchestra, the basketball team and the Hempfield Key Club. In addition, he has served as vice president of the Student Council, vice president of the junior class and president of the local 4-H Dairy Club.

The scholarship winners were selected by the Committee on Academic Standards of Penn State's College of Agriculture. The awards were based on scholarship, character and promise of usefulness in one of the varied fields of agriculture. The scholarships for the school

year beginning in September will be continued through each of the subsequent three years, contingent upon favorable recommendation by appropriate college authorities.

Applications for next year's PP&L agricultural scholarships and other necessary materials for high school seniors who may wish to enter the competition will be available at every high school in the PP&L service area this fall.

Funds are still available for cost-sharing under the 1960 Agricultural Conservation Program, the Land office announced this week. Practices include seeding or fertilizing grassland, establishing four strips, terraces, ditches, open or tile drainage waterways, and planting trees to improve a stand of trees.

Interested farmers have not already signed should contact the office as soon as possible. Soil tests for the requirement must be made by either the County or State College for practice requiring lime, seed or fertilizer according to Landis Carter, in charge of the office.
