

When the cows are milked in the evening they get a mixture of home grown grains and a commercial protein at the ratio of one to five during the summer months and about one pound of grain to four pounds of milk in the winter

In addition to pasture, grain, and green chopped alfalfa, the dairy cows reed in eating and gets more feed into her, Keener be-

This week Keener was making the first cutting of DuPuits alfalfa from a field which is four years old Last year the field was harvested five times "We should have made this hay 10 days ago, Keener said, "But the weather held us up like everybody else"

Another indication that the May milk flow was no accident is the continued high production from the herd during the past several years. During 1958 the herd average was 474 pounds of butterfat per cow It slipped slightly during 1959 because of some breeding difficulty,

but Keener is shooting for near 500 pounds per cow this year

If present indications bear out, the goal should not be out of reach

One cow in the herd, Levcl Valley Pabst Lillie, has produced 611 pounds of fat in 16,045 pounds of milk in just 240 days and she is still in a good milk flow. 'It looks like she might make 706 pounds this year" Keener

Lillie and two other cows on three-times-a-day milking, but the rest of the herd 13 milked only twice One of the first calf heifers




