Coeur a la Creme Though lighter in calories than most desserts, it's weighty in satisfaction

COEUR A LA CREME
2 pints cottage cheese, sieved
2 cups dairy sour cream
1/4 teaspoon salt
2 tablespoons (2 envelopes) unflavored gelatin
1/2 cup milk
Fresh Strawberry Sauce
Beat cottage cheese, sour cream and salt until smooth. Sprinkle gelatin on milk to soften, stir over hot water until dissolved and blend in cottage cheese mixture. Spoon into heart-shaped mold or individual molds. Molds which have been rinsed with cold water. Chill until firm. Serve with Fresh Straw

berry Sauce. Garnish with whole berries dusted with confectioners' sugar, if desired.

FRESH STRAWBERRY SAUCE

3/4 cup sugar
2 tablespoons cornstarch
3/4 cup orange juice
1/4 cup lemon juice
1 pint fresh strawberries
1 tablespoon grated lemon rind
Sift together sugar and cornstarch into small saucepan. Stir in orange and lemon juices and cook, stirring constantly until thickened. Remove from heat. Wash strawberries; reserve a few for garnish and dice remaining strawberries. Stir diced berries and lemon rind into sauce, chill until ready to serve.

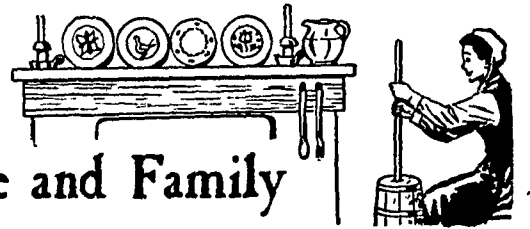
SOUR CREAM RAISIN PIE

1 cup sugar
1/2 teaspoon cinnamon
1/2 teaspoon cloves
2 eggs, beaten
1 cup seedless raisins
1 cup sour cream
Salt
2 tablespoons vinegar
Baked 9-inch pastry shell
Mix all ingredients, stirring until sugar is dissolved. Pour mixture into shell and bake at 350 degrees 25 to 30 minutes.

SPICED CREAM PIE

2 eggs
1 cup sour cream
1 cups seedless raisins
1 cup sugar
1 tablespoon flour
1/2 teaspoon cinnamon
1/2 teaspoon cinnamon
1/2 teaspoon salt
Beat eggs until light; add sour cream and raisins. Blend sugar, flour, cinnamon, nut-

meg and salt and add to first mixture. Line piepan with pastry and pour in filling. Place thin strips of pastry across top of filling. Bake in hot oven (425 degrees) 15 minutes. Then reduce temperature to moderate (350 degrees) and continue baking until filling is firm, about 30 minutes. Serve hot. Makes 1 (9-inch) pie.

SOUR CREAM DRESSING

1 cup dairy sour cream
1 tablespoon chopped chi-

ves or minced onion.
2 tablespoons vinegar (Tarragon is excellent)
1/4 teaspoon salt
1/8 teaspoon pepper
1/4 teaspoon sugar
1/2 cup mayonnaise
Mix the first six ingredients together carefully, then fold in 1/2 cup mayonnaise or salad dressing.

SOUR CREAM OLIVE FRUIT DRESSING

1 cup sour cream
1 cup finely chopped ripe olives
1/4 teaspoon celery salt
2 teaspoons sugar
2 teaspoons lemon juice
Dash of salt
Combine all ingredients. Chill. Serve with any fresh or cooked fruit salad combination. Makes about 1 1/2 cups.

SOUR CREAM SAUCE

1/2 cup butter or margarine
1 cup confectioners' sugar
1/4 teaspoon lemon juice
1/4 teaspoon vanilla
1/4 to 1/2 cup sour cream, plain or whipped

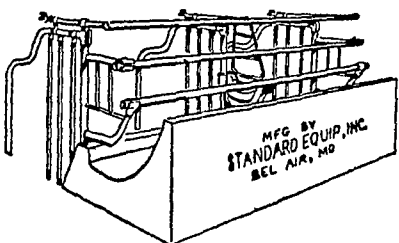

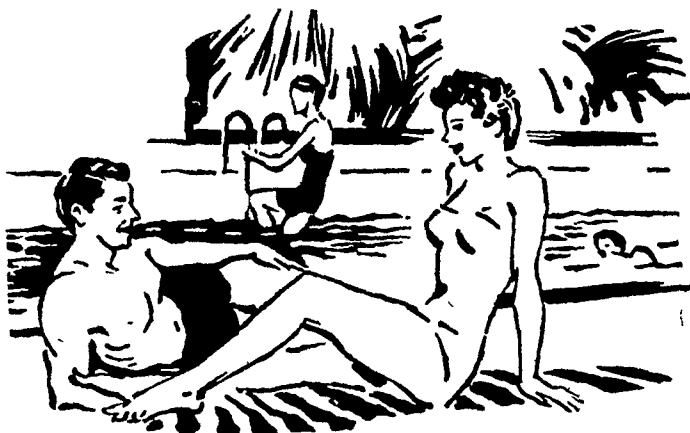
