New Chemical Gives Effective Fly Control

The U. S. Department of State University make Diazinon a first choice for control of flies in barns and buildings, too. Diazinon is used in four ways to control flies in dairy

barns and other buildings.
1. Residual Spray. Apply to the point of run-off a spray of 2 to 4 quarts of Diazinon 25E (or 4 to 8 pounds of Diazinon 25W) in 25 gallons of water to ceilings and walls. Do not spray animals or contaminate their feed and drinking water.

2. Spot Bait Spray. Spray a mixture of 1 pint of Diazinon 25E (or 1 pound of Diazinon 25W) and 1 pound of sugar in 2½ gallons of water at doorways, windows and other areas where flies tend to congregate.

3. Liquid Bait Sprinkle a mixture of 4 ounces of Diazinon (or Diazinon 25W) and a pound of sugar (or 2 cups of molasses) in 5 gallons of water lightly over floor areas frequented by flies. Or sprinkle the mix on burlap bags.

4. Maggot Control. As a course spray or from a sprinkler, apply a mixture of 4 ounces of Diazinon 25E (or Diazinon 25W) in 5 gallons of water over each 500 sq-foot fly breeding area such as on manure piles and wet spots. Apply Diazinon to the poultry droppings only if the birds are on wire.

Repeat the applications of Diazinon in all control methods as fly populations warrant. Liquid baiting will be required every one or two days.

Do not slight sanitation in and around livestock buildings this summer; with timely, thorough sprays and baits of Diazinon, it will help you control flies.

Record Price Is Paid For Holstein Bull

University Park — Two famous Pennsylvania Holstein cattle have produced a bull calf that recently sold for \$10,000, the highest price paid for a Holstein at public auction since 1957.

The calf, Penstate Pathfinder Ivanhoe, was born to Penstate Inka Pathfinder Star, State University cow whose record of over 1,000 pounds of butterfat for six consecutive years leads the nation.

The sire is Osbornedale Ivanhoe, outstanding gold medal bull owned by the Southeastern Penna. Artificial Breeding Cooperative, Lancaster. Ivanhoe is rated as one of the most popular sires among Holstein breeders throughout the United States.

The record price of \$10,000 topped the diamond jubilee convention sale of the Holstein-Friesian Association of America, held at Syracuse, N. Y. Penstate Pathfinder Ivanhoe was bought by the Hamilton District Cattle Breeding Association of Hannon, Ontario.

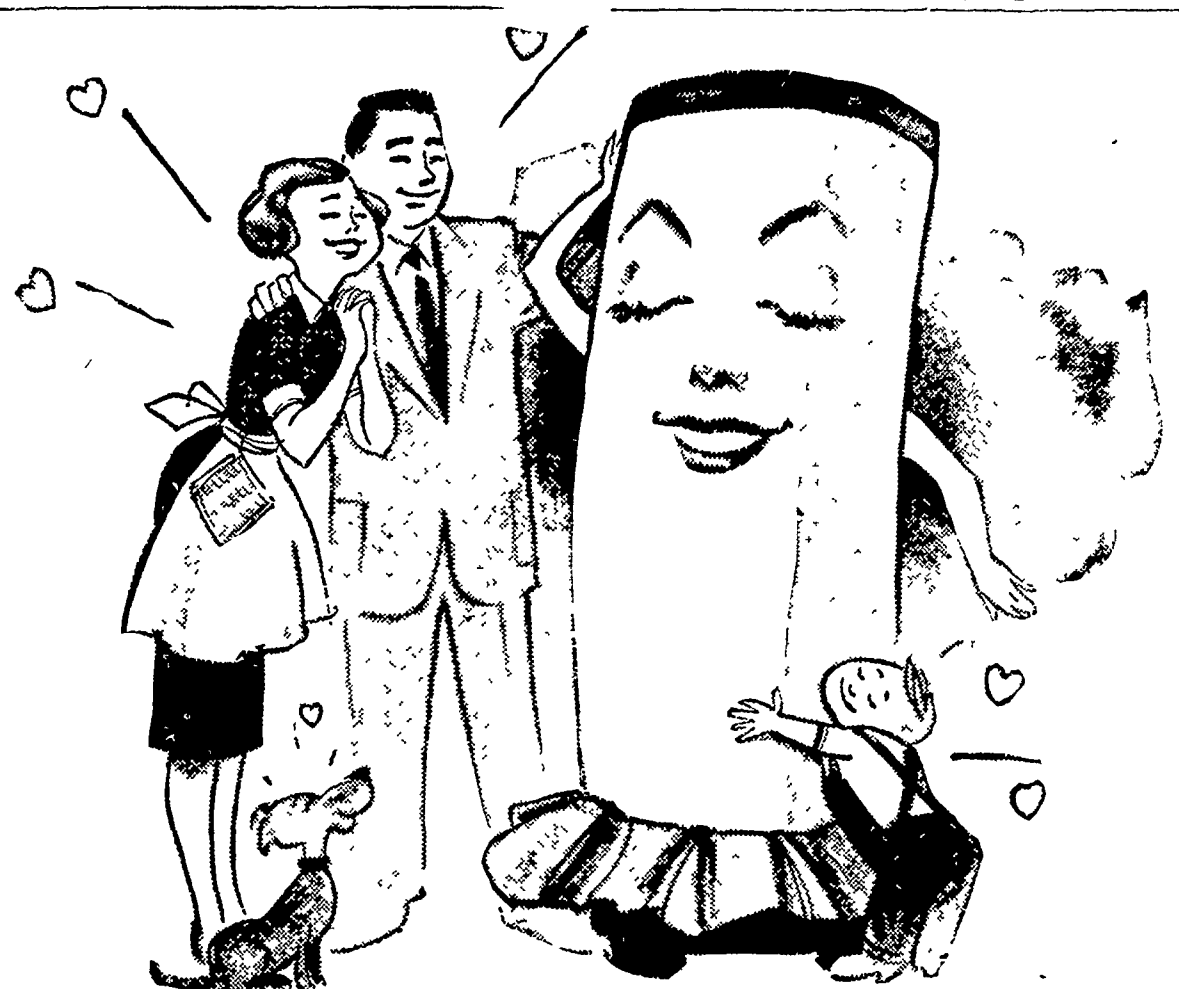
