

## Lanc. Poultry Center Broilers Up Full Cent

Almost all kinds registered at the Lancaster Poultry Center this week with broilers up more than a cent over last week.

The June 23 sale offered a total of 92,050 head in 37 lots.

Broilers ranged in price from 19.3 to 21.1 for 71,800 birds in 18 lots. Last week's sale ranged from 18.2 to 20.0. Five lots of 5,900 Leghorn brought 15.1 to 15.3. Four lots of 2,550 heavy pullets made 21.4 to 26.0 while 4,850 cockerel roasters in five lots brought 20 to 24.0.

## Delmarva - Georgia Broiler Market Gains Half Cent

The broiler market in Delmarva averaged about 1/2 cent higher during the 24 hour period ending 10:30 Friday morning. Prices paid at farms for 716,600 head ranged from 18.35 to 19.30. Offering of live birds was barely adequate as the demand for the available birds improved late in the week.

Estimated slaughter by Eastern Shore processors for the weekend is 660,000 head compared to the 620,000 head last weekend. The Delmarva broiler-feed ratio for the week ending on June 17 was steady with the previous week at 3.9. Broiler prices averaged 18.10 and mash cost \$92.02 per ton. The ratio six months ago was up to 4.4 when broilers averaged 20.32 and mash cost \$93.25 per ton.

Estimated slaughter by Georgia processors for the weekend is 2,310,000 head compared to the 1,925,000 head last weekend. Georgia reported prices at farms during the 24 hour period ending 10:30 Friday morning ranging from 17 to 18.2.

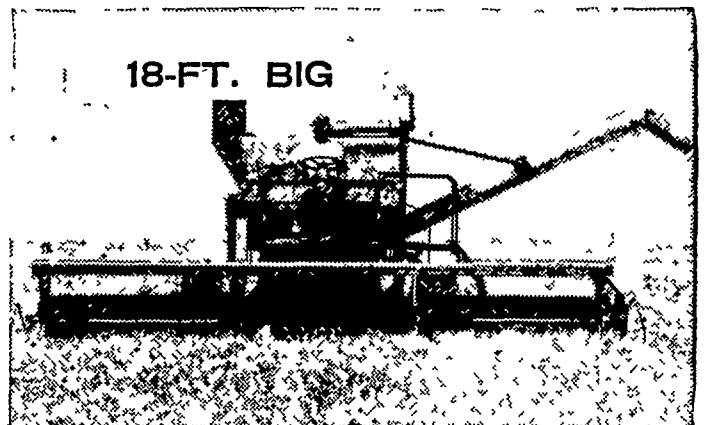
