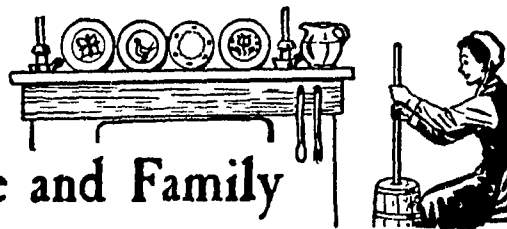


1/2 cup diced baked or boiled ham  
1/2 cup chopped celery  
1/2 cups finely diced raw potatoes  
1 cup instant nonfat dry

milk  
3 tablespoons flour  
1 1/2 teaspoons salt  
1/4 teaspoon pepper  
3 1/2 cups warm water  
In a saucepan, melt butter

then saute onion, ham and celery. Add potatoes and cook over low heat 10 minutes. Remove from heat. Mix nonfat dry milk, flour, salt, pepper and water; add to cooked mixture. Return to heat and cook, stirring occasionally, about 15 minutes.

#### GREEN BEAN-HAM CASSEOLE

1 package frozen French-cut green beans (or fresh may be used)  
1 1/2 cups liquid  
3 tablespoons butter  
3 tablespoons flour  
1/2 teaspoon salt  
1/2 cup instant nonfat dry milk.  
2 cups chopped, cooked ham  
1 tablespoon chopped parsley  
2 tablespoons chopped pimento  
2 hard-cooked eggs, chopped  
1 teaspoon finely chopped onion  
1 cup shredded sharp Cheddar cheese  
1/2 cup buttered cracker or bread crumbs  
Cook green beans according to package directions; drain, reserving liquid to combine with water to make 1 1/2 cups. In a saucepan, melt butter; blend in flour

and salt. Add liquid and nonfat dry milk and cook, stirring constantly, until thickened. Remove from heat and add ham, parsley, pimento, eggs, onion and cheese, blend well. Place beans in baking dish and cover with sauce. Sprinkle buttered crumbs over top and bake 20-25 minutes in a 350 degree oven 6-8 servings.

#### RASPBERRY CHIFFON PIE

1 9-inch baked pie shell  
1 package raspberry-flavored gelatin  
1 cup boiling water  
1 12-ounce package frozen raspberries, partially thawed  
1/4 cup sugar  
1 tablespoon lemon juice  
1/2 cup nonfat dry milk  
1/2 cup water  
Dissolve gelatin in boiling water. Add raspberries, sugar and lemon juice. with fork break apart frozen pieces. Cool to jelly-like consistency. Beat nonfat dry milk and water until very stiff. Fold into gelatin mixture. Turn into pie shell. Chill until firm.

#### COOL-AS-A-CUCUMBER SALAD

1 package lime-flavored gelatin  
1 cup boiling water  
3/4 cup cold water  
1/2 cup lemon juice  
1/2 cup instant nonfat dry milk  
1/2 cup dairy sour cream  
1/4 cup chopped green pepper  
2 cups chopped cucumber  
1 teaspoon onion juice  
1/8 teaspoon salt

Dissolve gelatin in boiling water. Add cold water and lemon juice; cool to jelly-like consistency. Add nonfat dry milk; beat until fluffy. Fold in remaining ingredients. Turn

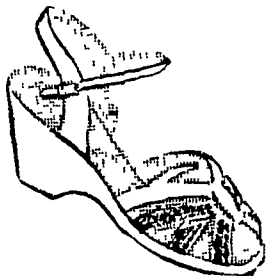
