Givler, as chairman of the plowing contest announced that entry blanks for the contest are available by writing to him at 1711 Lincoln Highway East, Lancaster or by calling Lancaster, Express, 71148. Deadline for the entries to be in the hands of the committee was set for July 26.

All entrants in the contest must be at least 16 yrs of age, Givler said, and must accompany the entry blank with a two dollar entry fee which will be refunded when the plowman shows up at the contest with tractor and plow. Only the first 15 applications received can be accepted, he said.

Winner of the county contest will compete for the state crown in Franklin Co next month. The state contest will have entrants in

both level land and contour plowing.

The first conservation field day sponsored by the SCD has been scheduled for August 24 on the Clarence Garber farm, Willow Street R2. The cooperating agency chairman will meet on the farm on July 19 to plan the program for the day.

Tentatively planned to follow the format of the popular dairy cattle field days the conservation program will feature soil judging contests, exhibits and demonstrations.

Meanwhile, the district approved the applications for conservation plans by two new cooperators. The approval of the two plans brings the total of new plans this year to 120. The plans will go to H. A. Joyce, Kirkwood, Colerain twp for 96 acres and Karl V. Peters, Columbia R2, West Hempfield twp, for 20 acres.

So we begin with an known quality of nitrogen left after harvesting the crop. How much remains in the plant root zone available to the next crop? be influenced by soil temperature and moisture. physical properties and action, type of soil and rainfall distribution amount.

When the complete answer to the nitrogen story is known we may be able to save fertilizer by decreasing the amount lost during the winter and by determining what amount is left in the soil.

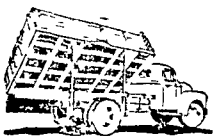
