

## Broilers Lose A Fraction

Prices were easier at the Lancaster Poultry center this week reflecting the ship prices on the Delmarva market.

Sellers at the July 14 sale offered 126,810 head in 44 lots and sold 106,510 head in 38 lots. The six lots of broilers not sold included 20,300 birds and received bids of 18 1/4 to 18 7/8.

The 21 lots of 89,975 broilers sold went to processors at prices ranging from 18 3/4 to 20 1/4.

Leghorn fowl shipped only slightly as 10 lots of 10,475 head changed hands at 13 9/16 to 14 1/4. Two lots of 860 heavy fowl made 18 to 19 1/2.

Three lots of 2,700 pullet roasters changed hands at 23 1/4 to 25 1/2, while two lots of cockerel roasters could make only 22 1/2.

Live broiler prices averaged approximately one cent lower at Delmarva during the 24 hour period ending 10 30 a.m. Friday morning. Offerings were generally adequate for the demands with demand for ready to cook poultry slightly improved.

Delmarva reported prices of 17 60-19 50 on 818,500 head. Estimated slaughter in Delmarva for the week end is 652,000 head compared to the 696,000 head last week. The Delmarva broiler-feed ratio for the week ending July 8 was up three points from last week at 4 4

mand was generally only fair with offerings ample to excessive in many cases. The New York milkshed reported surpluses ample to burdensome with prices unchanged to 15 cents lower or as low as \$4.85. Unverified reports indicated still lower prices being received for loads that were diverted to manufacturing outlets. There was also noted increased dried milk production in upstate New York areas. Wholesale selling price for 49 quart unit of bottling quality milk in New York ranged from \$4.85 to \$4.95 with most of the sales at \$4.90 and \$4.95.

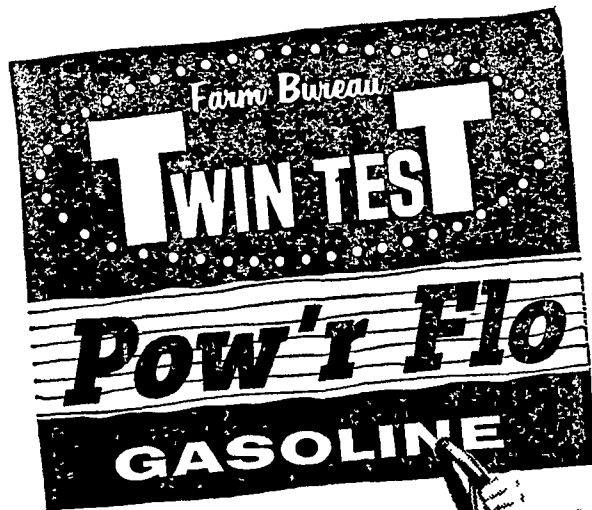
