show the poultrymen his 11,000 broilers and 45 acres in vegetables for the Philadelphia and Lancaster markets.

The 3,000 White Leghorn layers, and pullets on six acres of range at the home of Roy Book, Ronks R1 and the 3,600 Leghorn layers in the remodeled barn of Harold Brubaker, Strasburg R1 will compete the morning session of the tour.

After a picnic lunch at Black Rock Retreat, the group will observe mushroom spawn operation on the farm of Paul Farron, Kirkwood.

The 12,000 layers in the windowless house on the Joseph Leslie farm, Oxford R2 are fed and watered automatically. The temperature in the house is controlled by thermostat and manure is removed daily by a pit cleaner. Growers will also see Leslie's 22,000 broilers, 4,000 pullets, 104 sheep, and 90 acres of Christmas trees.

A stop at the caged layer operation of Warren and Robah Hess, Quarryville R1, will complete the tour. The Hess family houses 3,500 caged layers in a 300'x30' insulated concrete block house.

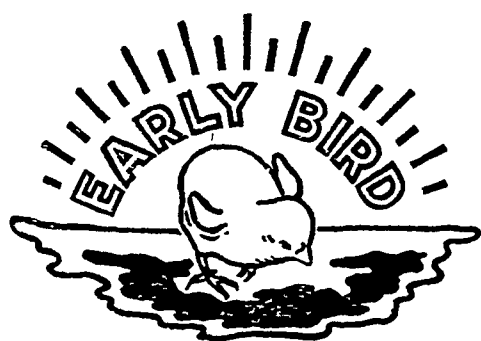

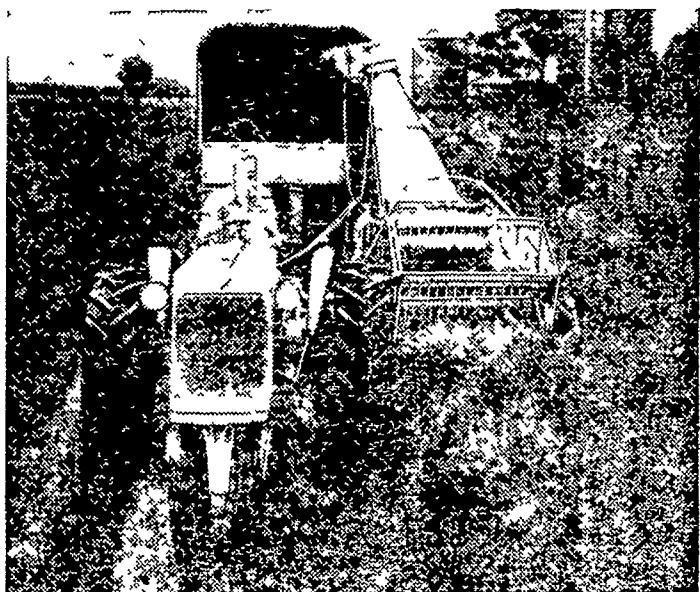
