dred yards up the road has been remodeled for the family of Reber Testerman, manager of the farm.
"The program is not in full swing yet," Testerman said this week. "We have been building a lot of fence and trying to get the barn in shape. Right now we have 32 head of horses on the place. Pasture for 82 dairy heifers has been rented to neighbors this year," Tennessee Walking Horse stallion, the future herd sire of Shady Brook. "That stud is the grandson of the great Midnight Sun, former world

champion walking horse. He was foaled at Athens, Ohio and taken to the annual sale of walking horses at Lewisburg, Tennessee as a yearling."

The walking horse gait, the source of delight to a fancier of the breed, is one of the traits Shining Sunday's passing on to his foals. One filly only a few weeks old romping in the pasture behind her dam hits the huffing gait as naturally as most foals trot.

At the present time, most of the mares in the herd are grades. Herr purchased a group of mares on a buying trip to Kentucky to get the Pride in good stock shows like a light when Ben-Herr begins talking about Shining Sunday, the registered breeding farm into operation, but plans are to gradually sell off the grades and replace them with registered walking horses.

Four foals were born on the farm last year. This year the yearlings have to move

over to make room for the nine foals already dropped this year. One of the new arrivals is a registered Standardbred filly, a daughter of Balkan Hanover, the well known trotting stud.

Most of the crop farming on the farm is for the production of feed for the horses. Testerman harvested 17 acres of oats this year and has already stored over 4,000 bales of hay. Most of the hay is a mixture of red clover and timothy or a grass hay.

Eighteen acres of corn is also producing horse feed for the winter.

"Meadow grass hay makes a good horse feed, but you have to be careful feeding too much legume hay," Testerman believes. The 23 acres in ladino clover, however, provides good pasture and hay for milking mares and foals.

Herr, one of the moving forces in the Valley Lea Riding Club often invites the organization to use

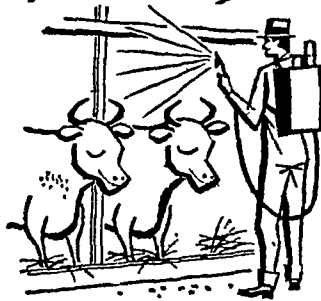
Shady Brook as a starting point for their trail rides. "We have trails or access to dirt roads from Mount Nebo through Tucquan Hollow and Holtwood to Benton's Hollow below Fishing Creek," he says. There are approximately 18 or 19 miles of trails for the horse back riders without using hard roads.

Fishing Creek and the site of the new State Park are less than two miles from the farm. The 300 acre spread is ideally located for pleasure horse riding, and will soon be ideally equipped for (Turn to page 7)
