rainy weather of the season have so restricted the honey flow in many county areas

that bees have not stored enough feed for themselves through the winter. Clarke cited examples of colonies which produced over 300 pounds of honey last year and have not made enough this year to fill one super.

Speaking at a twilight meeting in the apiary of Alen Millhouse, Millersville, Clarke told the 30 beekeepers, "I know we all hate to think of feeding bees during the first week of August but some colonies, and some strong colonies, have not stored enough honey this year to maintain themselves. We have found some colonies today on the verge of starvation. These will have to be fed if they are to be
