Poultry prices held steady at Lancaster Poultry Center. Last week as 10,550 head of corn fowl in 10 lots sold at prices ranging from 13.7

5. Broilers were down almost 25 percent from last week as 25 lots of broilers including 100 head brought 17.6 to 18.4 with over 85 per cent of the sales under 18.4 cents. One lot of 5,050 pullet made 23.2 to 26.3. One lot of 280 heavy sold for 18.

Delmarva reported prices of 17 to 18.20 on 735,200 head at farms during the 24 hour period ending 10:30 on Friday morning.

The Delmarva broiler-feed ratio for the week ending on July 29 was steady at 4.0 as broilers brought 18.03 and mash cost \$90.49 per ton.

Production levels were generally maintained for declining only seasonally; however in Southeastern Pennsylvania slight increases were noted as declining production appears to have been arrested. Bottling demand was slightly improved but still no more than fair. This situation found some burdensome offerings reduced with most manufacturing outlet of cheese and related products able to utilize existing surplus. Wholesale selling prices at New York were \$4.90 to 5.20 per 40 quart unit, with most of the sales at \$5.15 and 5.20.

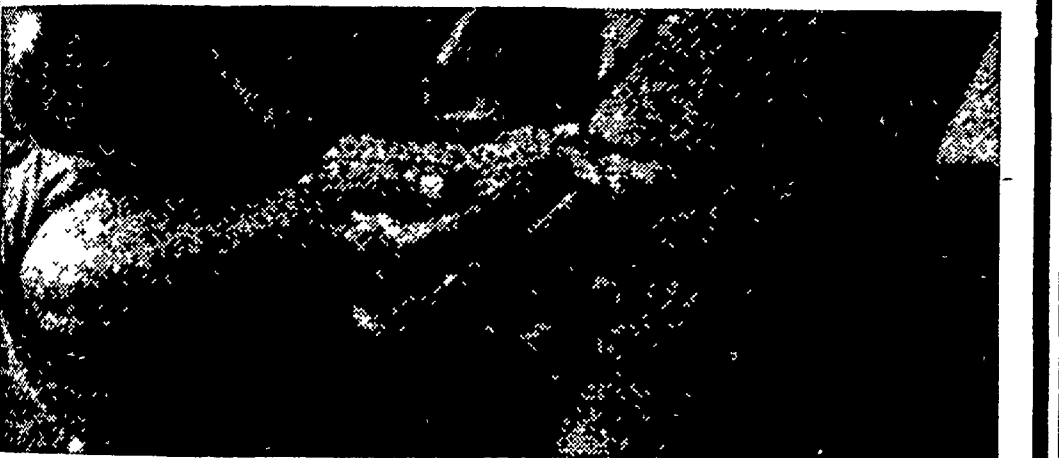
