Prices Over June Under Last July

Harrisburg — Pennsylvania farmers averaged slightly more for their products in July than in June, but still were not paid as much as they were a year ago, the State Crop Reporting Service revealed today

Prices received in mid July for agricultural products averaged nearly 2 percent higher than a month earlier, the State Agriculture Department agency said, but were slightly lower than a year ago. Higher fruit, vegetable and milk prices during July slightly more than offset the lower food grain and livestock prices

A \$22.90 per ton average for hay was the lowest July price in 11 years.

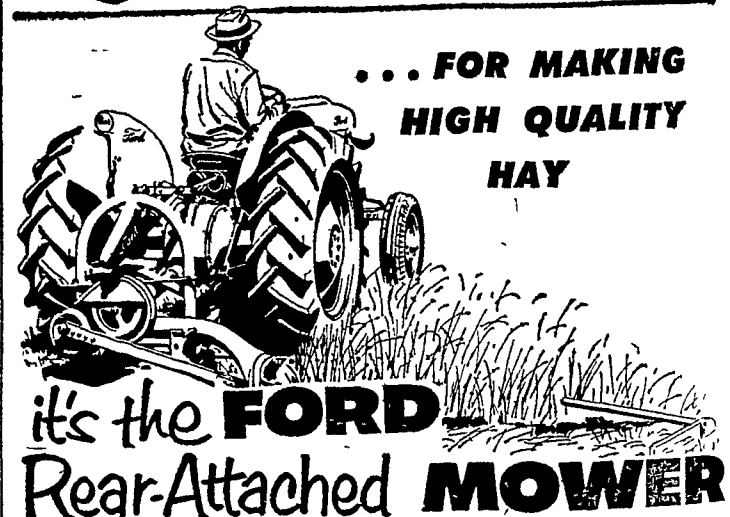
