

Prices Up Almost 1/2 Cent

Broilers at the Lancaster Poultry Center this week reflected the rising market in Delmarva when prices on the 5,440 head in 28 lots ranged from 18 to 19 4 for an 18-1/2 average. The average at West's market was 18-1/2.

Eight lots of 8,000 leghorn were made 13 9 to 14 6 while a lot of 850 heavy fowl bid at 18 5. Two lots of chicken roasters including 650 head brought 22.9-24.6, and six lots of 4,225 pullet nesters changed hands, at 14 to 22 2.

The August 11 sale offered a total of 138,500 head in 10 lots and sold 119,565 head in 45 lots.

About 1/2 Cent

Delmarva reported prices of 16 1 to 19 on 650,300 head at farms during the 24 hour period ending 10:3 Friday morning. This is about 1/2 cent higher than the previous day Offerings were ample for an improved demand.

Estimated slaughter by Delmarva processors for the week end is 668,000 head compared to the 633,000 of last week end. The Delmarva broiler-feed ratio for the week ending August 8 was steady for the third week at 4.0. Broilers compares with the 3.4 ratio (Turn to page 2)
