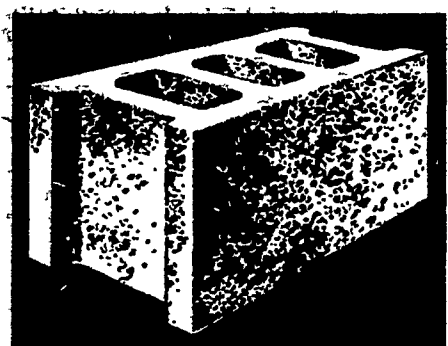

Applications to enter the show must be made prior to September 1. Entry blanks are to be returned to McCool by October 1. Between October 1 and the opening of the Farm Show on January 9, 1961, samples of milk from the farms and dairies will be collected by State Department of Agriculture milk sanitarians and scored for quality.

Dates for the 1961 Farm

Show are January 9 through 13. Entry blanks to enter live stock, poultry, produce and home crafts will be included in the Premium List. The Premium List should be available through County Agent's offices about October 1.

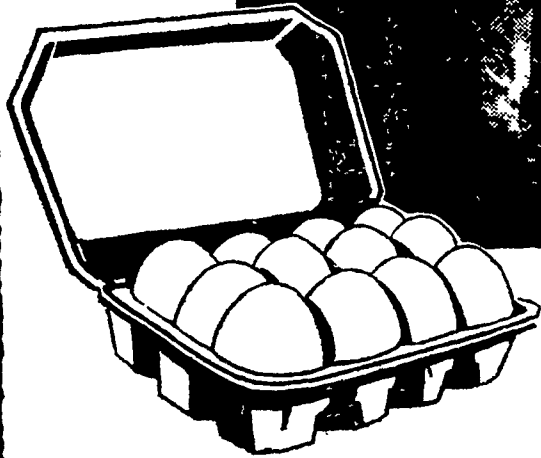
