Broilers Continue Steady

Prices were about steady for broilers at the Lancaster Poultry Center as broilers ranged from 17.5 to 18.00 for 80,700 head in 18 lots. Only 4,100 head were sold. These were three lots which went to the buyers at higher than bulk of the broilers. Other 15 lots were all under. Seven lots of 6,450 leg-fowl ranged from 14.6 to 15.9 while 250 other fowl lot made 15.0. Fowl corresponding sale were brought 8.6 to 9.0. Lots including 8,600 broilers made 23.6 to 24.9 while three lots of 2,775 broilers brought 28.0. Sold were two lots of 1,000 and two lots of broilers. The broilers were bid 24 and 24.9 and bids of 16.5 and 16.5 were refused for the broilers. The complete September sale offered 109,725 head in 39 lots and sold 98,825 in 35 lots. Delmarva - Georgia Prices Drop Only Fractionally

Delmarva reported prices fractionally lower during the 24 hour period ending 10 30 Friday morning. Offerings were fully ample for the needs. At farm prices ranged from 16 to 17.30 for 779,300 head. Estimated slaughter by the eastern shore processors for the weekend is 647,000 head compared to the 666,000 head last week end. The Delmarva broiler feed ratio for the week ending on August 26 was steady at 3.7. Broilers averaged 17.26 and mash cost \$92.42 per ton. The ratio for the same period last year was 3.4 when broilers made 16.37 and mash cost \$94.90 per ton.

Fluid Milk Bottling Demand Fair To Improved

Production was fairly well maintained and generally above a normal seasonal level. Bottling demand was fair to improved, especially in metropolitan areas as schools prepare to open and consumers return from resort areas. Excess continued to move to manufacturers but at a reduced rate. Demand for cottage cheese and sour cream was generally good to seasonally improved.
