**Poorly Lighted Farm Machines Cause Accidents**

State Traffic Safety Commissioner O. D. Shipley said recently adequate lighting of horse or tractor-driven equipment pulled over highways during dusk or darkness should be of paramount interest to Pennsylvania farmers.

"The number of traffic accidents resulting from inadequately lighted farm equipment admittedly is not great—but virtually all are preventable," said Shipley.

Shipley noted that there're many reflective materials that will afford at least minimum protection against a possible collision which could result in costly property damage or serious bodily injury.

For a nominal expenditure

farmers can purchase any one of a variety of reflective materials, such as paint, plastic or glass.

"As a rural resident, I have personally been confronted by unilluminated, slow-moving wagons on narrow country roads," said the Commissioner.

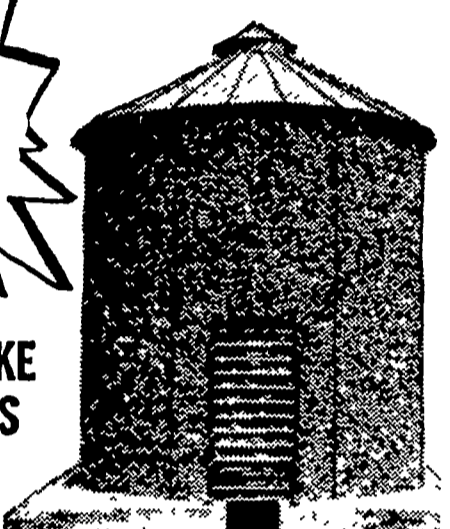
tension director, announced today He is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Norman E. Garber, Mount Joy R2.

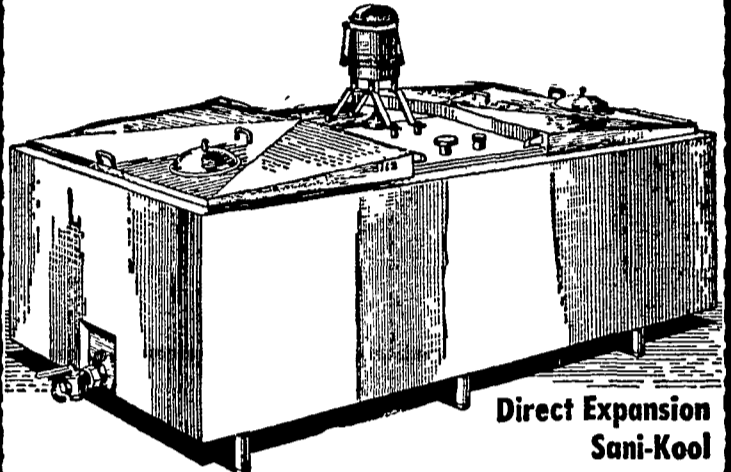

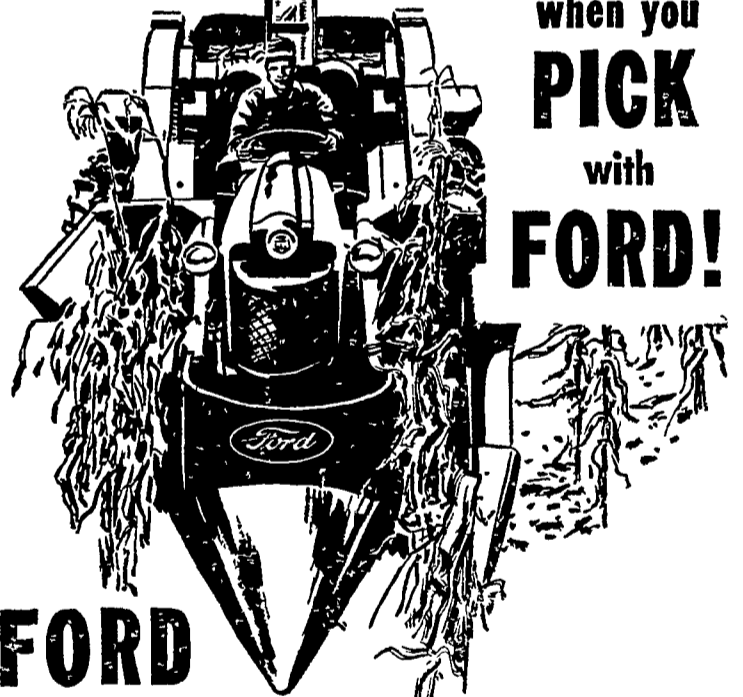
