## Hunting To Be Permitted On Most State Park Lands

Harrisburg — Secretary of Forests and Waters Maurice K. Goddard said recently that the State Parks will be opened to hunters again this year except where hunting will conflict with other park uses or will interfere with construction work.

Chief exception to the open hunting rule is Gifford Pinchot State Park between Harrisburg and York, where heavy construction will continue through the Fall and Winter.

Another large park under construction, Prince Gallitzin State Park in northern Cambria County, will be opened to hunting, however.

Goddard explained that hunting has generally been permitted in order to keep park wildlife populations in balance. He added, however, that hunting is not one of the primary recreation activi-

ties for which parks are built and that the State Park Service will assure that other activities may continue without interference during hunting season.

Goddard stated that the State Parks are used during all seasons of the year by non-hunters, particularly school groups and Saturday hikers. During October, November and December of last year, he stated, there were about 700,000 people who used the parks for purposes other than hunting as opposed to just under 50,000 hunters. For this reason "safety zones" have been established where hunting is prohibited. The Parks will be open during the bow and arrow season as well as the regular gunning season.

compel us to move in the direction of resorting to the full, free market structure by simply lowering the level of price supports. Neither does it lend itself to raising that support level to a point that would theoretically provide an equitable income for all farmers.

"Slogans like 'get the government out of agriculture' are pure nonsense. We're going to continue to have farm legislation and programs just as we have business and labor legislation and programs.

"Farm legislation should be designed to help farmers achieve a reasonable degree of effective regulation of marketings, place responsibility for the control of surpluses in the hands of producers, secure income from consumers rather than taxpayers, and develop economic powers comparable to those used by organized labor and most industries through use of producer-managed marketing machinery that would place farmers in a better position to obtain a reasonable income from market sales—not the government."
