Freys Honored By Holstein Association

Brattleboro, Vt — J Mowery Frey & Son, Lancaster R7, have qualified for the Progressive Breeder's Award — the highest recognition attainable by a breeder of registered Holstein cattle.
 This honor has been accorded to only 436 Holstein breeding establishments, including 47 in Pennsylvania. This is the third time that the Freys have been so recognized.
 The Freys' herd completed its latest Herd Improvement Registry testing year with a lactation average - calculated on a two milkings a day, 305 day, mature equivalent basis — on 63 individual records of 13,812 lbs of milk and 545 lbs of butterfat.
 The herd has also been officially classified for type with a breed age average of 102.7 per cent — obtained by dividing the classification score of each cow by the average score of all registered Holstein cows of the same age.
 A certificate of this award has been sent to the Freys' by the Holstein-Friesian Association of America.

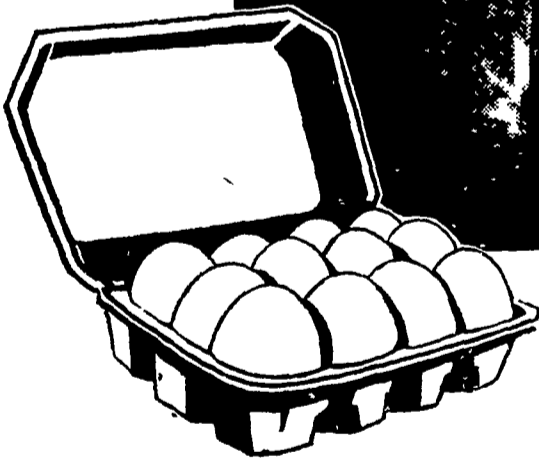
