Two Cash Grants Go To Poland Penna. Bans Del. Swine

Two research grants totaling more than \$19,500 - one to the University of Pozan and the other to the Institute of Plant Protection, both at Pozan, Poland - were announced today by the U. S. Department of Agriculture.

A grant of 617,600 zlotys, (\$11,229) was awarded to the University for a four-year investigation of the relationships between certain classes of chemicals in wheat wheat flour, and malted wheat. The aim of the study is to obtain fundamental information on the role of these compounds in utilizing the grains, especially in the making of bread.

HARRISBURG — State Secretary of Agriculture William L. Henning this week banned movements of live swine into Pennsylvania from the state of Delaware.

The emergency action was taken because hog cholera is known to be approaching epizootic (near epidemic) proportions in Delaware and because it is known that full foreign currencies accruing to the credit of the U. S. from the sale of surplus agricultural commodities abroad under Public Law 480.

The research is administered by foreign research and technical programs division of USDA's Agricultural Research Service.

ly virulent, live virus vaccine is being used indiscriminately in Delaware to combat disease. Hogs vaccinated with live virus can spread the disease to healthy hogs. Use of live virus vaccine is prohibited in Pennsylvania.

The embargo on Delaware hogs will be in force until such time as official notice is received that the current epizootic among the Delaware swine is under control.

Under terms of the embargo which became effective Sept. 16, no individual partnership or corporation is permitted to bring into, transport across or sell in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, any swine from the State of Delaware.
