Supplies of chicken continue bountiful and cause this item to be listed among the good meat buys. 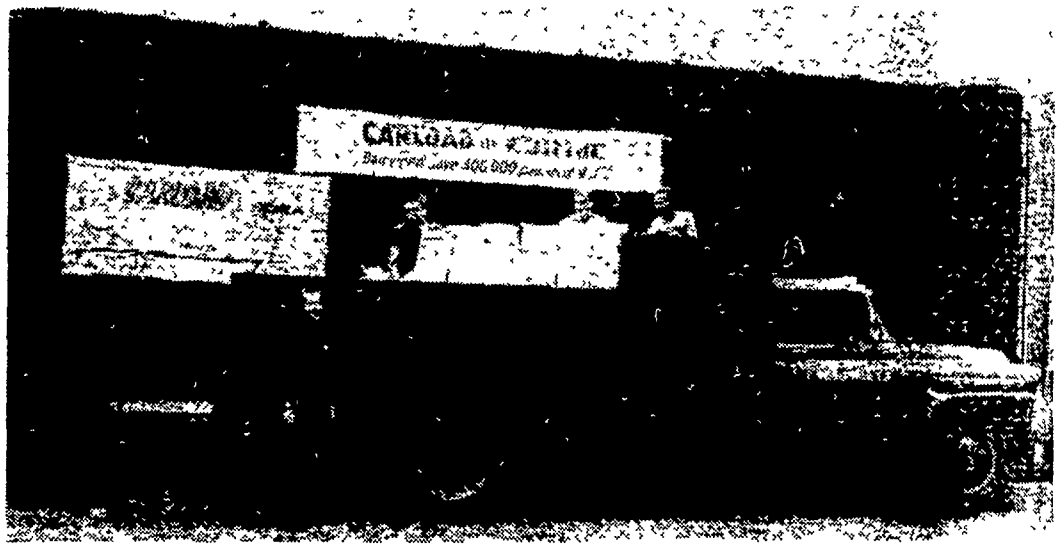
