The 4.6 cow average in the herd of Wilbur Hiestand, of Salunga was second in the herd average placings. The registered holsteins made 1,362 pounds of milk, 53 lbs. of fat, and averaged 3.9 per cent test.

Only five other herds in the county averaged 50 lbs. or better of butterfat during the month.

PRUNE FOREST TREES

Pruning young forest plantings "as long as you can reach the branches with a pruning hook" assures clear straight trunks, and provides a better timber crop, says E. P. Farrand, extension forester at Penn State University. He adds, should be pruned down to one vigorous leader for development in a longer main trunk.

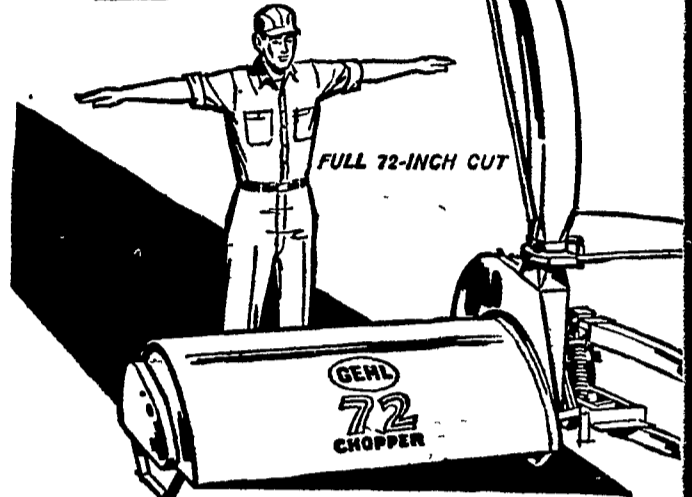

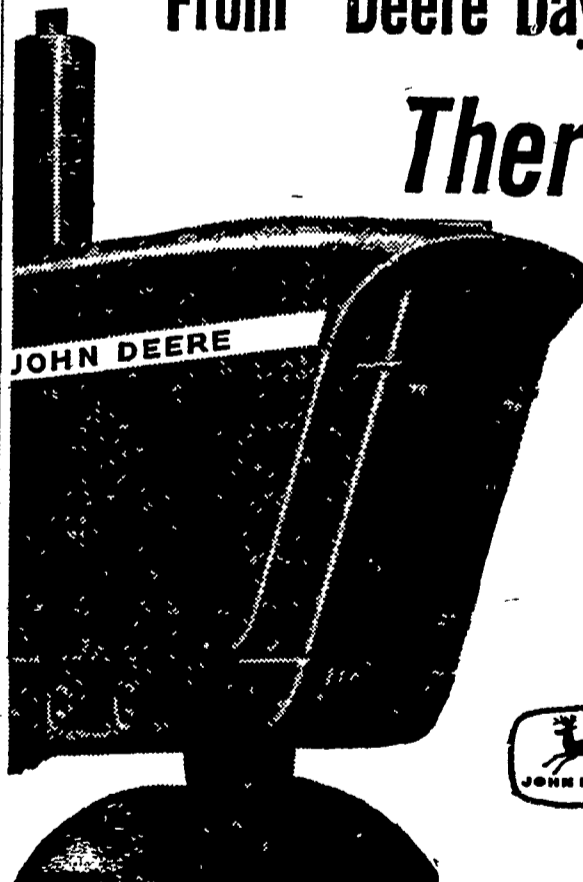
