One diplomat with Far Eastern experience, who asked that he not be quoted directly, summed up the Chinese situation this way: "The Communist Chinese are rabidly anti-foreign and anti-Western Russia is

foreign and Western. If Mao and Chou decide to conquer Southeast Asia by force, against Russian advice, there is a fair chance Russia would be not an active ally of the West, at least stay out of a Far Eastern war.

The difference is that the price fixing in nonfarm industry is done privately, with a certain amount of government consent and help, whereas the price fixing in agriculture must ne-

cessarily be done by the government.

This situation leads the businessman and politician to confuse competitive free enterprise with the absence of government interference, Dr. Henning said, "They are inclined to think that the steel industry is a true example of private enterprise while they think of agriculture as a socialized non-competitive industry."

"A moment's thought will show that nothing could be farther from the truth," He said.

Agriculture is not a de-

clining industry, but some editors can not resist putting agriculture headlines in the negative form, the Secretary feels. He pointed out the technological advances which have made it possible for a smaller percentage of the total population to produce the food and fiber for the rest of the nation.

"As the population grows, more farm products will be consumed . . . Hence, agriculture is a growing, not a declining, industry," Dr. Henning said.

The Secretary concluded by saying there are still those in this country who do not appreciate that it is America's productive agriculture and industry that have made America strong.

Some Suggestions To Help Reduce The Percentage Of Condemnation In Broiler Flocks

1. Practice a rigid culling program, starting on the first day. Remove all sick and ailing birds from the flock.
2. Provide adequate brooding heat.
3. Install a water medication system. Start necessary treatment immediately. Don't wait for the bulk bins to become empty.
4. Use a sound vaccination program.
5. Maintain better control of ventilation by use of heat in the winter and fans in the summer. Use of a maximum-minimum thermometer may be beneficial in keeping check on temperature fluctuations in the house.
6. Study condemnation report to see what you can do to decrease rejects.
7. Use disposal pits or incinerators to get rid of all dead birds.
8. Remove all birds from the broiler house. Don't leave any potential carriers of disease to spread the infection to the next brood.
9. Remove old litter immediately after flock is sold. Do not refill for at least two weeks.
10. Clean up poultry house promptly and thoroughly between each lot.
