fresh, frozen or canned
1 cup cooked rice (cooked in chicken broth)
1 cup chopped celery
1 cup sweet pickle-relish
2 tablespoons minced onion
3 hard-cooked eggs, chopped
3 tablespoons lemon juice
1/2 cup mayonnaise
1/4 cup chili sauce
Salt and pepper to taste
Miniature cream puffs made up as directed on package of Cream Puff Mix
Place crabmeat, rice, cel-

ery, pickle-relish, onion and eggs in a mixing bowl. Toss lightly. Sprinkle with lemon juice. Add mayonnaise and chili sauce to moisten. Season to taste with salt and pepper. Chill until just before serving time. Slice the tops from cream puffs and with crabmeat mixture replace tops.

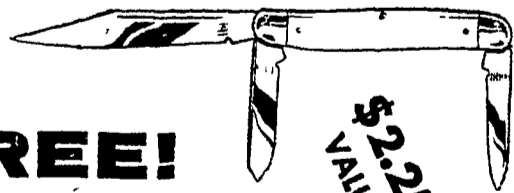

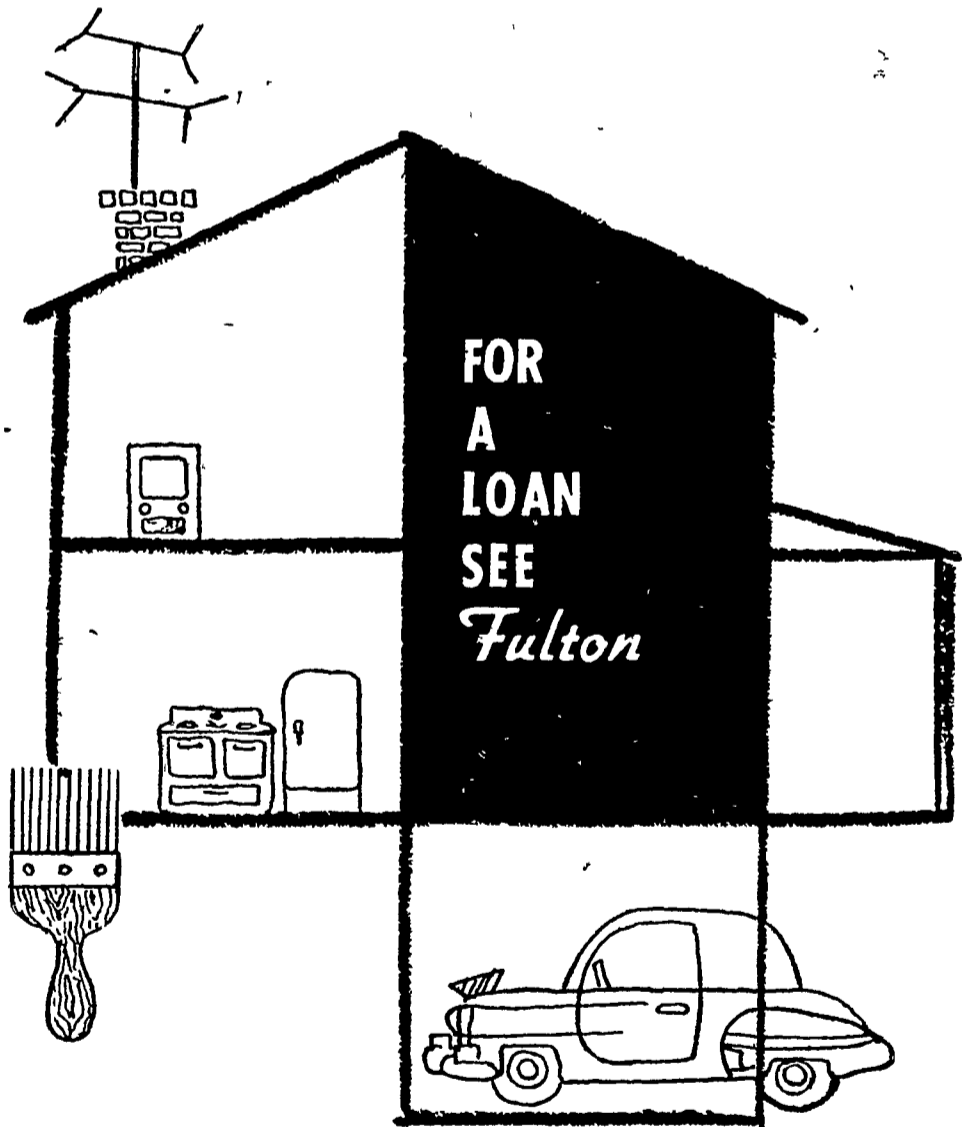
