

Buttered casserole. Cover with tuna fish, shrimp, and crabmeat. Add mushrooms, cheese, and salt. Make white sauce of butter, flour, salt, pepper, and milk. Pour over contents of casserole. Mix bread crumbs and butter, sprinkle over top bake in a moderate oven (350 degrees) 35 minutes.

ROLLED FILLET WITH GREEN RICE

2 pounds fish fillets (sole, haddock or cod)
Melted butter or margarine
1 1/4 cups chopped parsley
Salt and pepper
2 onions, chopped
1 green pepper, chopped
1/4 cup butter or margarine
1 cup tomatoes
1 bay leaf
2 teaspoons oregano
1 teaspoon salt
1/4 teaspoon pepper
3 cups cooked rice
1/2 cup cooked frozen peas
Brush filets with melted butter or margarine; sprinkle

with 1/4 cup chopped parsley. Season with a little salt and pepper. Roll up and secure with toothpicks. Saute onions and green pepper in butter or margarine until tender. Add tomatoes, bay leaf, oregano, salt and pepper. Cook for 20 minutes. Add fillets and cook in tomato mixture for about 10 minutes or until cooked through. Combine rice with remaining 1 cup of parsley and peas. Form into a border on platter. Spoon fish fillets in the center. Makes 6 servings.

ESCALLOPED CLAMS

1 pint warm milk
2 beaten eggs
2 cups cracker crumbs
1/2 cup margarine (reserve a little)
1 small onion cut fine
Blend above ingredients together well. Salt and pepper to taste. Fold in 2 small cans minced clams and liquid. Pour into greased casserole. Dot with remaining butter.

Bake 45 minutes at 350 degrees. Serves 5.

CALIFORNIA CHICKEN

1 1/2 cups diced carrots
1/2 cup chopped onion
1 1/2 cups diced potatoes
1 cup peas
1 can tuna fish
2 cups milk
2 tab'spoons butter
4 'ablespoons flour
Cook carrots, potatoes and onions together; then add peas drained. Make white sauce of milk, flour, and butter. Add the tuna fish. Make layers of mixed vegetables and the creamed fish. Cover with butter crumbs and bake until browned on top.

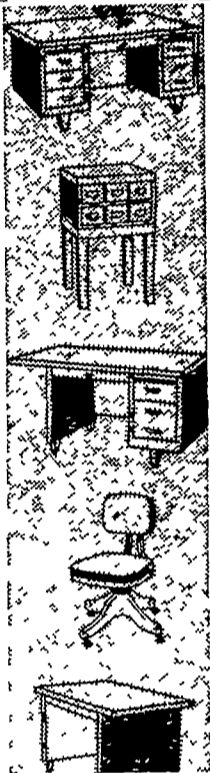

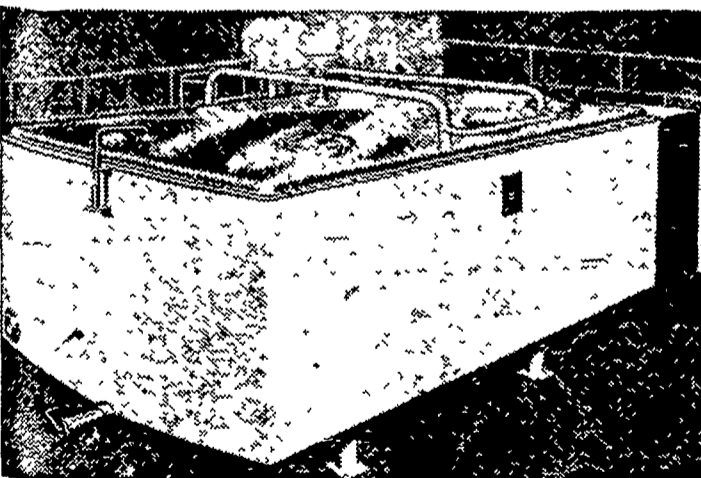

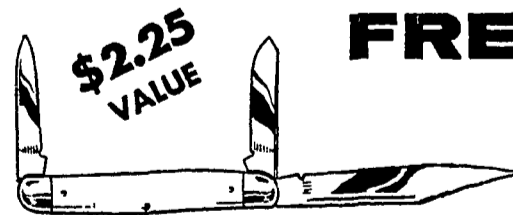
