

# Broilers Jump 3/4 Cent

Broilers took a good forward leap at the Lancaster Poultry Center this week as 1000 head in 16 lots sold for prices that ranged up to 3 cents above last week's. The sale average, however, was about 1/4 of a cent the previous week.

Broiler prices at the November 3 auction ranged from 17 to 18 1/2 with 87 per cent of the sales between 17 1/2 and 17 7/8.

Three lots of 4,500 heavy broilers brought 17 1/2 to 18 1/2. A lot of 300 males made 17 1/2 and four lots of leg-horn fowl including 4,400 broilers brought 13 1/2 to 15.6.

A lot of 500 silver cross pullets made 22 1/2 while 226 for 9,900 head in 10 lots.

The complete sale offered 7,755 head in 44 lots and 105,960 head in 35 lots. Following is the complete report with lot number, breed, grower in parentheses, amount and breed, age, weeks and days, buyer and price.

# Delmarva - Georgia Prices Gain On East Shore

Delmarva reported prices of 16 40 to 17 60 for 735,400 head during the 24 hour period ending 10.30 Friday morning.

Estimated slaughter for the week end by Eastern Shore processors is 628,000 head compared to 669,000 last week end.

The Delmarva broiler-fed ratio for the week ending October 28 remained unchanged at 38. Broilers averaged 16 54 per pound and mash cost \$87.12 per ton.

Georgia reported prices of 14 5 to 15 8 for 809,000 head at farms during the 24 hour period up to 10 30 Friday morning. Estimated slaughter for the week end by Georgia processors was 1,974,000 head compared to the 1,831,000 head last weekend.

# Fluid Milk Prices Advance On Nov. First

Production of fluid milk was generally well maintained to higher as warmer weather, especially in the New York Milkshed, reversed the downward trend of a week ago. Offerings were ample to excessive in most instances with surplus moving to separators.
