CATTLE: 3600. Compared with 5300 last week Supply included 20 per cent slaughter steers, 70 per cent stockers and feeders Trading moderately active Compared with last week's close, slaughter steers were steady. Cows were mostly 50 higher Bulls and stockers and feeders steady.

U S 1-2 190-230 lb barrows and gilts 19 50-20 50 No. 1 195-225 pound butchers 20 50-21, about 20 head high-yielding no. 1 190-220 lbs sold at 21 50. U S 1-3 190-240 lb hogs 18 50-19 50 few lots no. 3 18 25-240-260 lb butchers 18-18-50. Lot 262 lb no 3 17 50. U S 1-3, mostly 2-3, 300-600 lb sows ranged from 12-15

US Hog Grades Defined In New Booklet

Issuance of a new bulletin, "How Do You Hog Grade?", was announced today by the U. S. Department of Agriculture.

The 12-page publication designed for producers, describes and illustrates hog grades — U S No. 1, U S No. 2, U S No. 3 and Medium The fifth grade Cull, is described but not illustrated.

In addition the bulletin tells how grade is determined and gives information on other factors that affect market value of hogs
