

## Bids Firm On Light Listings

Receipts were down but sales gained this week at Lancaster Poultry Center as 43,830 broilers in 15 lots sold at prices of 17.5 to 18.7. Over 60 per cent of sales were between 18 and 18.2.

Sellers gave the nod to every lot offered for sale. This was the first time in over a year that not one lot was withdrawn for lack of sufficient bids.

Six lots of 12,375 leghorn pullets made 13 to 14.1. Four lots of 6,960 pullets brought 14 to 23.8 while bids of 10 to 24.1 took 3,100 roasters in three lots.

One lot of 75 geese crossed the auction block at 30.1. Listed and sold at the November 10 sale were 29 lots including 66,340 birds. Following is the complete listing with lot number, amount and breed, age in weeks, days, buyer and price.

The Delmarva broiler-feed ratio for the week ending November 4 was steady at 3.8. Broilers averaged 16.50 per pound and mash cost \$87.12 per ton.

Fluid milk production was irregular ranging from slightly lower to slightly higher. Irregularity was attributed to cooler weather and some freshening of herds.

Bottling demand was only fair. Offerings for manufacturing were adequate but lighter in many quarters.
