multiple uses to which the lands are put.

Last year 62 new branches of industries using wood or wood products came into the state along with 12 entirely new plants using forest products. For each cutting of timber on state forest lands last year, Pennsylvania had eight to ten bidders, and the forestry operation created over 300 full-time jobs for private citizens.

But in addition to the timber resources, the state forest lands are used for recreation - camping, boating, picnicking and hiking - hunting and fishing, and for watersheds and reservoirs.

More non-resident hunters from all parts of the United States pay for the privilege of hunting in Pennsylvania's game lands than in any other state.

The planned cutting of timber is one of the best methods of improving game feed and cover on the 52 per cent of the state which is covered by woods, Secretary Goddard said.

John C. Long, chairman of the Kiwanis Agricultural committee, was in charge of the program and presentation of the awards. Dr. Goddard was introduced by the County Agricultural Agent, Max M. Smith.

explained that all the strength of a nation has to stem from its resources. Most of us deal in services without really producing any wealth or strength, he said but resources must be put to their best use to make a nation strong.

Dr. Goddard told the group Pennsylvania now owns approximately two million acres of woodland in the state. "This is about one fourteenth of the total land area of the state," he said.

The state has recovered more per year from its forest lands than the total cost of the lands, he said. This is possible because of the

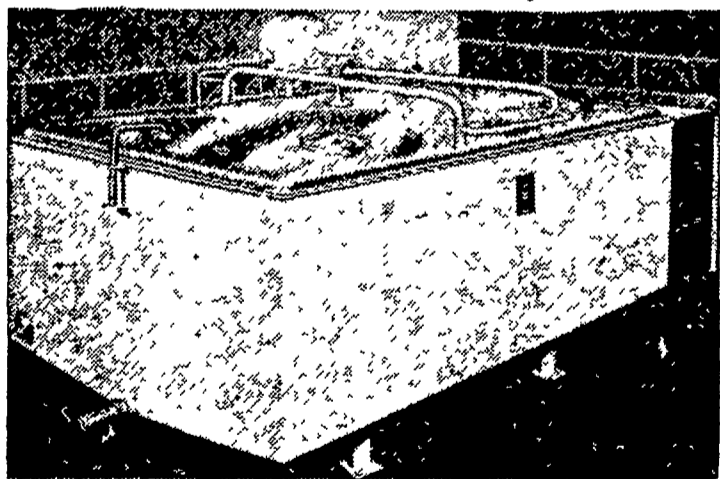

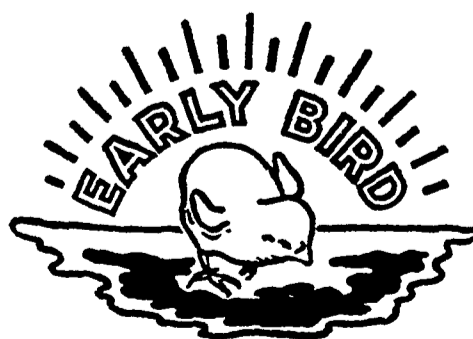
