# Prices Are Slightly Lower

Delmarva reported live prices averaged slightly lower during the 24 hour period ending 10:30 Friday morning. Offerings continued ample though wants generally within a more desirable range.

Prices at farms reported during the period ranged from 15 to 16.70 for 654,900 head.

Estimated slaughter by Eastern Shore processors for the week end was 655,000 head compared with the 712,000 head last weekend.

The Delmarva broiler-feed ratio for the week ending December 9 was up one point at 3.7. Broilers averaged 15.8 cents per pound and mash cost \$86.10 per ton. During the same week a year ago, the ratio was 4.3 when broilers were 19.94 and Mash cost \$93.28 per ton.
