The council voted to sup- port the Agriculture Center board of directors and to continue quarterly meetings.

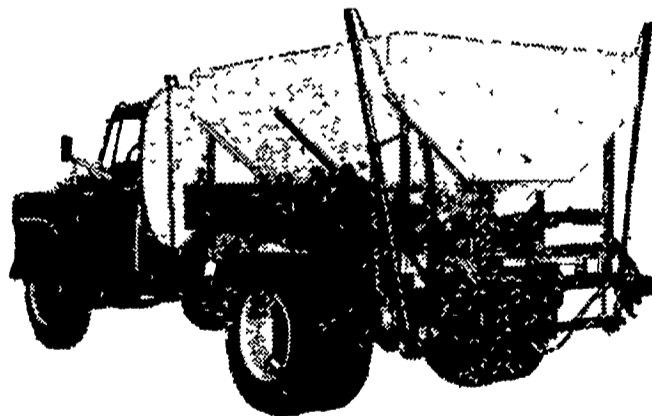
