

## Prices Off Fractionally

adders took all the birds red at the Lancaster Poultry Center this week. A lot of 61,700 broilers in 19 crossed the block at prices ranging from 173 to 194, a fraction of a cent below the 1807 of last week. Three lots of 3,000 roasts brought 25 to 27.6. One of 1,050 pullets made and five lots of 6,900 fowl changed hands from 121 to 133. The complete January 5th auction offered and sold 72,000 head in 28 lots. ## Delmarva-Georgia Prices Are About One Cent Lower

Live prices averaged about one cent lower at Delmarva. Prices of 16 to 18 for 511,000 head were reported during the 24 hour period ending 10:30 Friday morning. Estimated slaughter by Eastern Shore Processors for the week end was 580,000 head compared to 461,100 head last weekend. Offerings were generally adequate for current needs. Ready to cook demand was irregular though generally fair at most one cent higher delivered prices.

## Fluid Milk Production Is Up In N.Y. And Pa.

Fluid milk production was generally unchanged. Slightly higher levels were reported in New York and Pennsylvania as much as 10 percent above last month. Offerings were generally in excess of needs. Bottling demand improved as schools reopened. Wholesale selling price at New York was \$5.25 to \$5.30 per 40 quart unit of bottling-quality milk.
